**SHOW COMMITTEE:** The show committee reserves the right to cancel or split classes; limit class size; change arenas; limit the number of rides & number of horses per rider; and cancel or add judges. The show committee also reserves the right to refuse any entries. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. Sharps containers will be available in the stabling area and also in the show office for trailer in horses. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

**ENTRIES:** Accepted on first come, first served basis, based on (readable) postmark. Post entries (postmarked after closing date) will be accepted on a space available basis with late fee. Once the competition is filled a wait list will be established. Wait list will be maintained through April 21, 2011. Current 2011 RMDs entry form must be used. Proof of memberships and horse registrations must be included with entry. If entry is incomplete, horse/rider combination will be placed on the wait list until required paperwork is received. Times: provisional times available at [www.csdressage.org](http://www.csdressage.org). Official times will be posted at the show office. Numbers required all times when horse is outside of stall. Entry required if schooling only. Anyone not appearing for any of their dressage tests without prior notification to the show secretary will be "scratched" from their remaining classes. Those rides will be filled if possible. Freestyle entries MUST be accompanied by a photocopy of a test verifying eligibility to enter the class (i.e., **60%** at the highest test of the declared freestyle level or any test of a higher level from an USEF Recognized show) with the exception of FEI Young Rider and Junior freestyles. Any person wanting pony measurements must contact the show secretary before the show to set a measurement time. This time may be the afternoon of Friday, April 22nd.

**REFUNDS:** Up through closing date, all fees refunded except office fee. From day after closing to day prior to competition, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled from wait list. Qualifying fees and drug fee (if horse is not on show grounds) refunded. Stabling fees refunded if cancellation is on or before April 20, 2011. During competition days **no refunds including for Acts of God. Office fee is nonrefundable.**

**AWARDS:** Trophy & ribbon to first place; ribbons through 6<sup>th</sup> place. High Point Awards. USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal for Class #209. The winner must be a USDF GM, PM, or IM member, possess a USEF AA card and earn a minimum of 60%.

**STABLING:** Stalls are 12x12 permanent stalls with full sliding doors; stall fronts (including doors) are solid from midway down and bars from midway up. **Stabling available at noon on Thurs. April 21, 2011.** For other arrangements, please contact Heather.

**ARENAS** One or two outdoor 20 x 60-meter show arena, one outdoor warm-up arena; all sand mix footing. (Intro/Training Level classes may be held in 20 x 40-meter arena.) Arenas watered and worked throughout show. **Show arenas open for schooling Thursday and Friday afternoon/evening until show office closes.**

**VET/FARRIER:** On call, numbers posted in show office and stables. **EMT:** On-Site EMTs.

**CONCESSIONS:** Food available on premises. Other concessions/vendors, contact show secretary.

**OTHER:** Dogs must be leashed at all times.

From the South: Hwy 83 North, three miles North of Franktown is Bayou Gulch (at Ponderosa High School), turn East, CHP is about 1 mi. on the left
