Children under 10 yrs old	\$15.00

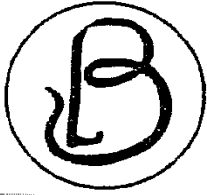
Late Entry (After September 5th):

This ride is not a CAHC sponsored activity, but an opportunity for all to ride this scenic ranch, have some good eats and enjoy our horses. Directions to the Lazy K-11 Ranch:

Take Highway 86 East to Comanche Creek Road (about 4 _ miles East of Kiowa) and go North. It is the only road you can go North on before you reach Comanche Creek Bridge. Go north approx. 5 _ miles to County Road 150. Turn East on County Road 150 and follow it for 5 miles. Cross a cattle guard, and look for the green gate on the south, with the Bijou Springs Hunt sign next to it. The gate is opposite Elbert County Road 85. Turn south and follow the road for one mile. There will be signs directing you where to park.

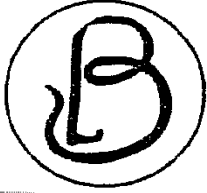
