

KENLYN GROUP POKER RIDE FUNDRAISER/FUN RIDE AND LUNCH
RIDE ROUNDTRIP FROM KENLYN to EMIL-LENE'S STEAK HOUSE
JUNE 4, 2011

RTR: 10 AM

Linda Fisher will host a poker ride/fun ride and lunch, starting at KenLyn Arabians. This ride incorporates a poker ride fundraiser for CAHC endurance. Poker hands will be sold at beginning of ride for \$15 each, riders can buy more than one hand to increase their chances of winning \$\$\$\$cash prizes\$\$\$\$.

The ride will leave KenLyn Arabians, travel through the Aurora City Trail system through the City of Aurora Open Space. The trails are dirt, sand, and crusher fines. Abundant wildlife can be seen: bald eagles, wild turkeys, deer, coyotes, prairie dogs, etc. The terrain is rolling hills and flat prairie, Sand Creek river bottom, and some stream crossings.

We will arrive at Emil-lene's Steak House for lunch. Riders will need to provide their own funds for lunch/refreshments, approx. \$20. Horses will be tied to trees during our lunch break. We will return to KenLyn, put horses up and gather to reveal poker hands and give out prizes. The total ride will be 6 miles roundtrip, riding time 3 hours total and 1 1/2 to 2 hours for lunch. Ride will start at 10AM and festivities will conclude no later than 4PM

- Ride Fee: Bring \$20 for lunch. You will have enough to order anything you want!
Alcoholic beverages can be purchased at this restaurant
- Date: June 4, 2011 Saturday 10 a.m. ready to ride from Kenlyn
- Ride Duration: 5 hours total - 3 hours roundtrip ride, 2 hour lunch
- Difficulty: Easy, shoes not necessary
- Trail Users: Hikers, mountain bicyclists, shared use
- Description: 5,000' elevation, creek bottom, groomed paths, and trails.
- Directions: I 70, take exit 285 (Airport Blvd) South, 2 1/2 miles to 10th Ave, Left to end of street. Parking behind Kenlyn
I-225, take 6th Ave exit, head East, 2 miles, Left on Airport Blvd, 1/2 mile, Right on 10th Ave to end of street. Parking behind Kenlyn
- Parking: Early arrival encouraged.
- What to bring: Camera, appropriate gear for weather, and helmets are encouraged.
Halters & Lead ropes (8'-10' long) for tying horses during lunch. Will tie to trees

Ride is limited to 25 riders. Please call 303-807-0062 to let Linda know you are coming. She will make reservations as the group leaves Kenlyn.
